Cindy has served as coordinator of the program for the past 10 years. The Smart Buddy mentoring program was started around 15 years ago by Pana district's previous Superintendent, Dr. David Lett, other district staff, and community members. Over the years, school staff members have also become volunteers. The program consists of teachers, nurses, bankers, construction workers, law enforcement officers, business owners, pastors, librarians, and retirees as volunteers. Cindy said, "I can honestly say that being the coordinator over the last 10 years has given me the opportunity to meet the most amazing, selfless people in this community. The recognition that I am receiving should go to them for their continuous commitment to the children in this school district."

Mentors in the SMART Buddy program meet with their "buddies" (at-risk students in grades K -5) 30-60 minutes a week during the school year. The mentor normally (but not always) begins working with a child in grades Kindergarten or 1st grade. Then that same buddy pair stays together until 6th grade or higher where they transition into the M2G program (grades 6-12). The overall goal is for the mentor to encourage their buddy by exemplifying positive words and values to them during their time together. There is a waiting list of at-risk students that need mentors so new volunteers are always needed.
