Carolyn and Kathy are retired English teachers who used art a great deal in their own classrooms in activities such as the Young Authors' Program for which students wrote and illustrated their own books. After Kathy's retirement in 2012, they were glad to become part of the Volunteer Art program started by Pam Painter and Tammy Winters and began working with the North Greene Elementary 4<sup>th</sup>- 6<sup>th</sup> grade students. Each class in each grade receives an hour of art instruction once a month. Each month focuses on a different art medium and the techniques of using it: pencil, chalk pastels, cray-pas, watercolor and acrylic painting are used each year. Elements of design and color are also taught along with care and maintenance of art materials. As pottery students themselves, these ladies enjoy working with the students in building clay pieces which are then kiln-fired and painted. Each year builds on the previous skills taught. While there is not always an artist focus, particular artists are brought into lessons and the foundations of what they learned in the lower grades is reinforced.

Carolyn and Kathy are very appreciative of having an art room in which to store materials and have classes. This allows for more time for instruction. They are also appreciative of those who make the program possible through their donations: Christ United Methodist Church, the NGE Parent-Teacher organization, and other organizations and individuals who generously give so the program can continue.

The first North Greene Elementary Art Show was held in the spring of 2013 and has continued annually. This event showcases the work of the student artists in grades K-6 as the all-purpose room is transformed into a small "art museum." Upper elementary students "mat" and prepare their work for display themselves. This year's event will be Wednesday, May 8<sup>th</sup>, 6-8 pm. The public is invited to attend and refreshments are served. Teachers are also encouraged to take their classes to see the displays the next day. It's great to see the talent of the young ones improve through the years. It is a rewarding culmination of the year's work.
