The Lions Club works with Sav-A-Lot for food items and Tri-County Feed and Seed for the holiday hams for Christmas dinner.

Thanks to the input from Washington and Lincoln schools, a baseline of those who may need help is utilized and all are notified of the process and how to apply. In addition, a general sign up day is posted in the community for those who have not been notified or have children who are no longer eligible for the Angel Tree (those over 12 years old). Casey's in Tower Hill graciously hosts the Angel Tree and assists in getting the tags out and gifts back as a central location. Through the efforts of their staff, they make sure all the tags are filled with gifts and back for pick up at the Lions Club, usually the Saturday before Christmas.
