This hometown organization has brought entertainment, recognition and support to the North Green area for over half a century.

Paul Fansler became a professional announcer in 1972. He began by promoting grudge racing for the purpose of interesting underprivileged children in racing street driven automobiles on a supervised racetrack, rather than on the highways and city streets.
